


DIY is a set of structural entities and green identities, presenting different smells, colors, textures, nuances, and of course special singularities... They are based on the basic knowledge, collected during many years of gardening experiences around the world, about the different successful combinations of plants.

The visitors will learn while playing. They will have a flyer, which exposes the profile of each variety planted in the boxes, and have to create combinations, paying attention to the 'like' and 'dislike'.

We want to create a buzz, based on the old word of mouth. DIY is the central point of a system, combining different tools (the flyer and an internet platform to collect the own knowledge) trying to keep alive the invisible heritage of gardening.









